Official Rules

1. Madill Gaming Center is a governmental enterprise of the Chickasaw Nation, (“Nation”) a federally recognized sovereign Indian tribe. Madill Gaming Center is giving away up to \$943 in Mystery Scratchers during the “Double Take Lunch Break” promotion.
2. Patrons must be 18 years of age or older with a valid photo I.D. The following individuals or entities are not eligible to participate or win during this promotional activity; employees of Madill Gaming Center; employees of the Nation prohibited from participating as set forth by any of the Nation’s policies, regulations, or laws; anyone who has been barred or banned from any of Nation’s gaming facilities; or any promotional sponsors.
3. Every Friday in January at 12:30 p.m., patrons who are actively playing on any electronic gaming machine will receive (1) Mystery Scratcher, while supplies last.
 - a.) Scratch cards will contain cash valued from \$1 to \$200.
 - b.) Patron must be actively playing with valid photo ID on their person.
 - c.) Scratch Card must be scratched off in the presence of a Madill Gaming Center Employee at the cash cage.
 - d.) Madill Gaming Center representative will verify if Patron is playing the machine at the selected time. If Patron is not actively playing, Patron will not receive prize.
4. Winner(s) are responsible for all applicable taxes. Winners will receive a W2-G and/or a 1099 tax form, when applicable, provided by the Chickasaw Nation.
5. Acceptance of prize constitutes winner’s permission for Nation to use his/her likeness or name for publicity or promotional uses without compensation or notice. Winner must agree to sign a publicity release form before prizes will be released.
6. Any situation or dispute not covered by these Official Rules will be resolved by Nation in a manner deemed by Nation to be the fairest to all concerned. Any such decision shall be final and binding on all Patrons. In addition, Nation reserves the right to void any entry, and/or change, cancel or modify this promotion at any time without notice. Upon any dispute resulting from game play, Patrons may file a Prize Claim with the Chickasaw Nation, Office of the Gaming Commissioner.
7. Participation in this promotion is an agreement to abide by these Official Rules. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification and a forfeiture of any prizes.
8. Participation in this promotion and/or tournament further constitutes the affirmative consent of each Patron to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Nation, its regulatory bodies and courts without limit to time or event, which shall govern this promotion.
